

Introducing the Prison-to-Gown Pathway (PGP) Program!



What is PGP?

The **Prison-to-Gown (PGP) Pathway** is a new initiative aiming to reduce the barriers that keep students impacted by the criminal legal system from gaining access to post-secondary education on the UIUC campus.

System-impacted students include those who have been incarcerated, detained, convicted but not incarcerated, those who have been charged and/or arrested but not convicted, and their families and loved ones.

What support do we provide?

PGP provides support to students who have interacted with the criminal legal system including academic assistance, peer-to-peer mentoring, digital literacy, housing support, and community resources.
